

**Summer Program Participation Agreement  
Conducted at Oklahoma Christian School, Inc.**

From time to time members of OCS teaching, coaching and administrative staff provide summer enrichment programs. Non-OCS students are welcome to participate in these summer programs. However, non-OCS students are considered for enrollment in the summer program only when invited by and participating with a currently enrolled OCS student.

Prior to participating in a summer enrichment program, both the participant and the parents of the summer program participant must understand and agree to the following:

1. Summer program participants will follow the directions and procedures of program staff. Disrespectful or disruptive behavior is not allowed. Continued disruptive behavior will result in dismissal from the summer program.
2. As with any public activity, an OCS students' behavior should reflect well on Christ and the reputation of OCS in the community. As such, serious disciplinary infractions by an OCS student could result in discipline at OCS, including having an impact on an enrolled student's enrollment status at OCS.
3. Parents will arrange for the prompt drop-off and pick-up of students; and only parents or legal guardians may pick-up students under the age of 16, unless prior arrangements are made between the parent/guardian and the teacher or coach.
4. At all times subject to OCS Policy and Oklahoma State law, summer program teachers, coaches and administrators are given full discretion in the discipline of summer program participants.
5. Appropriate OCS teachers, coaches or administrators reserve the right to dismiss a student from participation in the summer program for any reason he or she deems necessary for the success of the program or the reputation of OCS.
