



## SPANISH THREE HONORS - SUMMER ASSIGNMENT

**OBJECTIVES:** To continue practice using Spanish throughout the summer months so that you don't get "rusty". To learn how to type Spanish accent marks on any computer. These are important skills required at beginning of the school year in the Spanish III-Honors course.

### I. CONNECT TO GOOGLE CLASSROOM using code: muny43

You will receive reminders of assignments throughout the summer months through Google Classroom. You will also be asked to upload some items on Google Classroom as well. ### II. CONNECT TO DUOLINGO CLASSROOM using code: VPJEPY

You will need to practice using your Spanish through listening, speaking, reading and writing skills to improve your vocabulary and grammar. Instead of being assigned a specific assignment, you may choose assignments. You will be graded based on your XP points (experience points in the language) each week which come from how much time you spend practicing on Duolingo.

### III. LEARN HOW TO TYPE SPANISH ACCENT MARKS ON COMPUTERS

You will receive a sentence each week of the summer via Google Classroom. You will need to create a Google Doc and share it with the teacher. Go to the following website to see how to use accent marks on different devices: <http://joyoflanguages.com/how-to-type-spanish-accents/>.

Please type a header as shown below. For each week you will need to write the dates of the week as shown below, and then type the sentence 10 times using the accent marks. Number each sentence. On Google Docs, the teacher can see if you typed each sentence individually for practice or if you copy and pasted the sentence. So please type each sentence individually.
